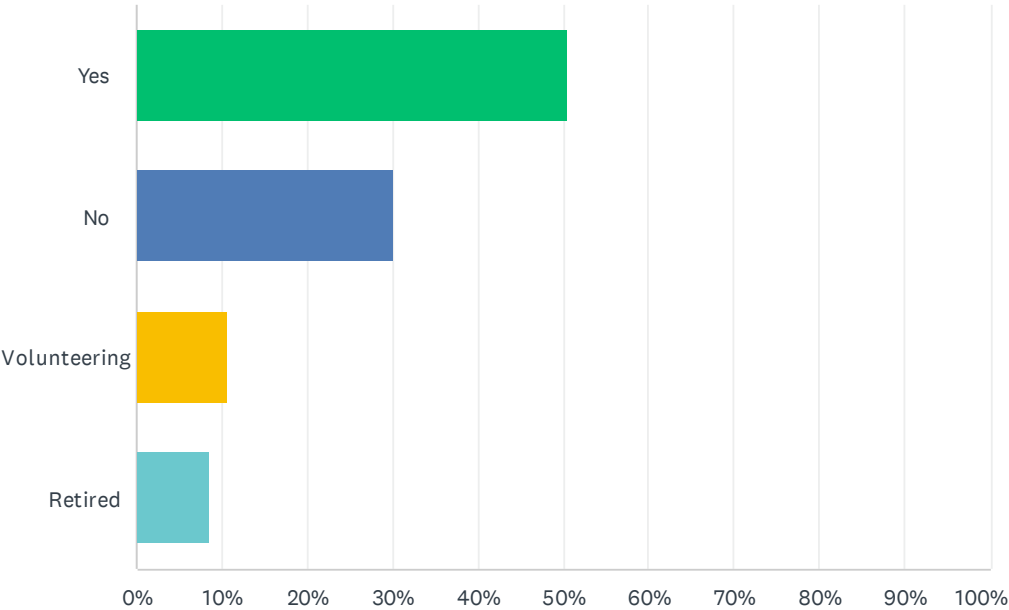

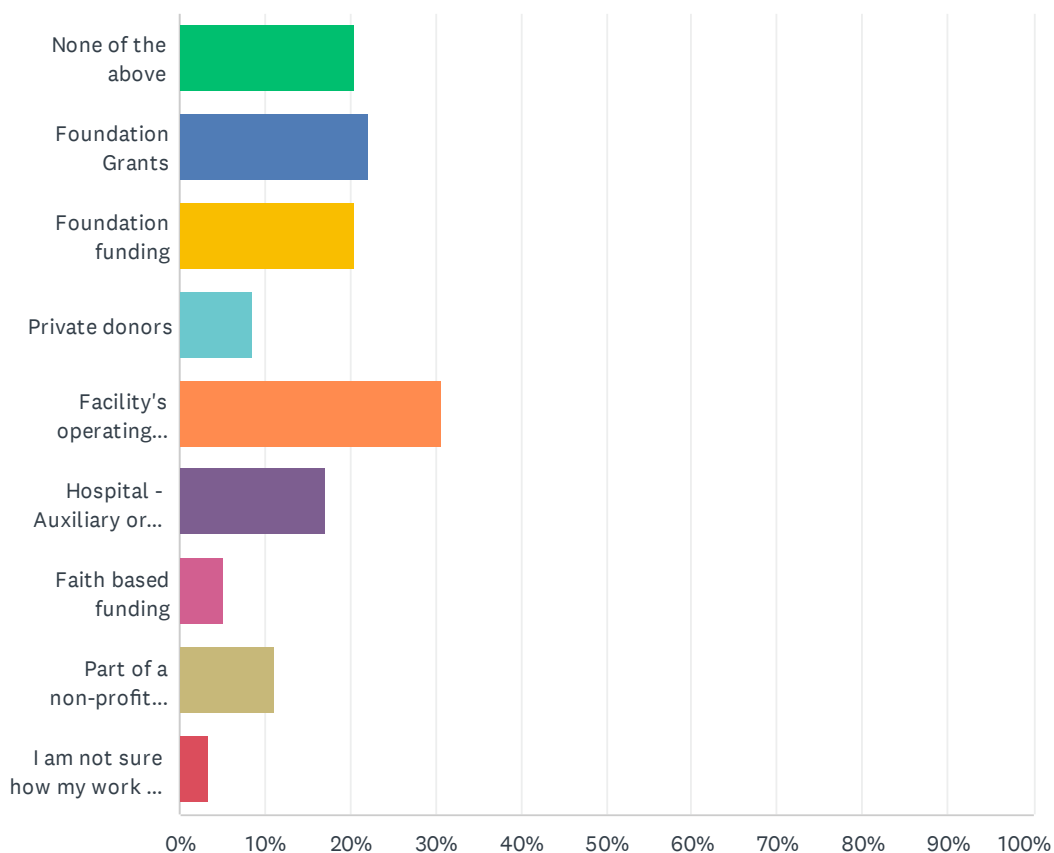

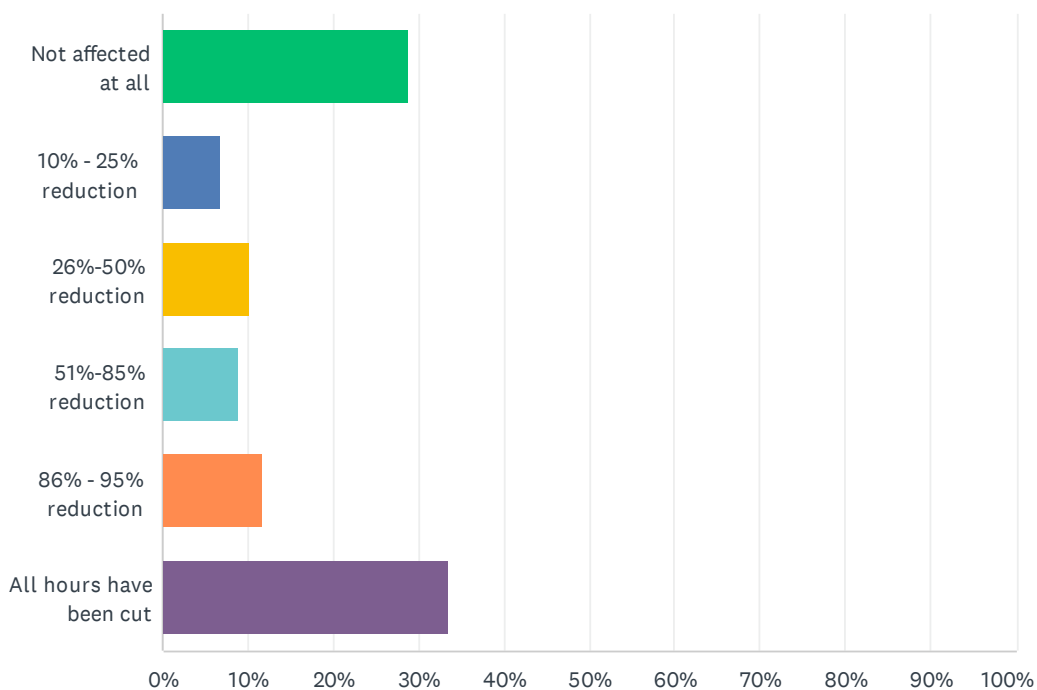

Q8 How has the pandemic affected your hours working as a CMP?

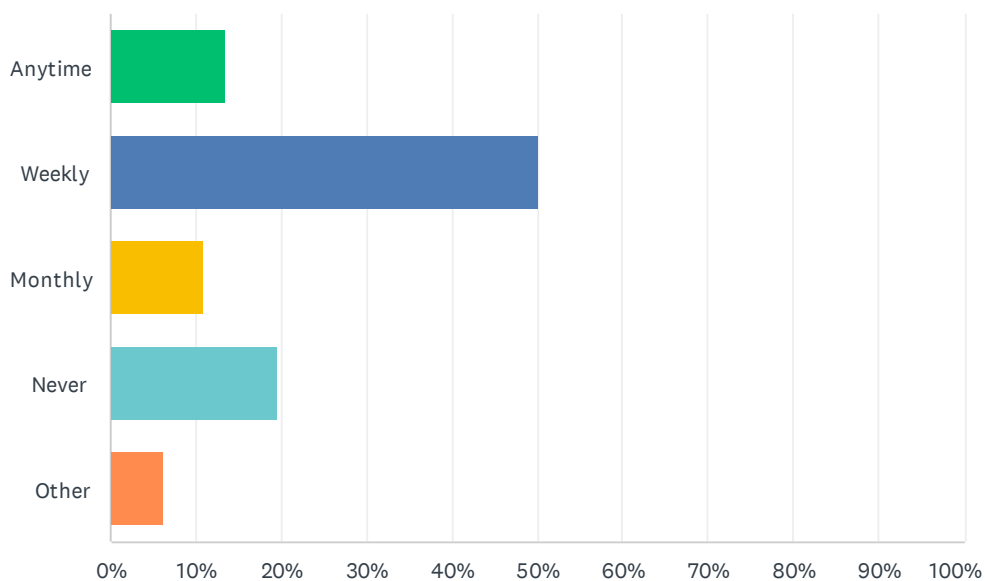

Q9 How often do you play in person at your facilities?

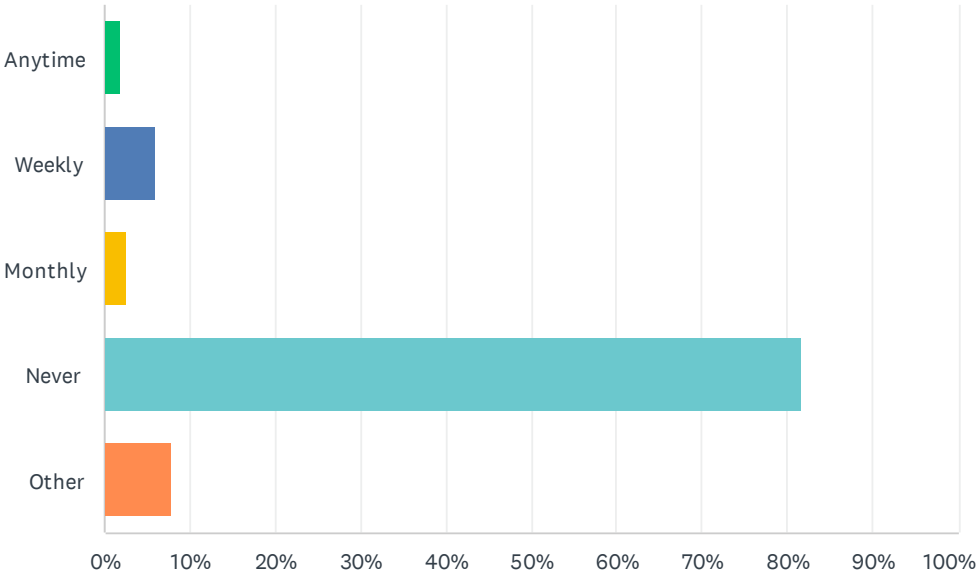

Q10 How often do you work as a CMP virtually via tablet or other device?

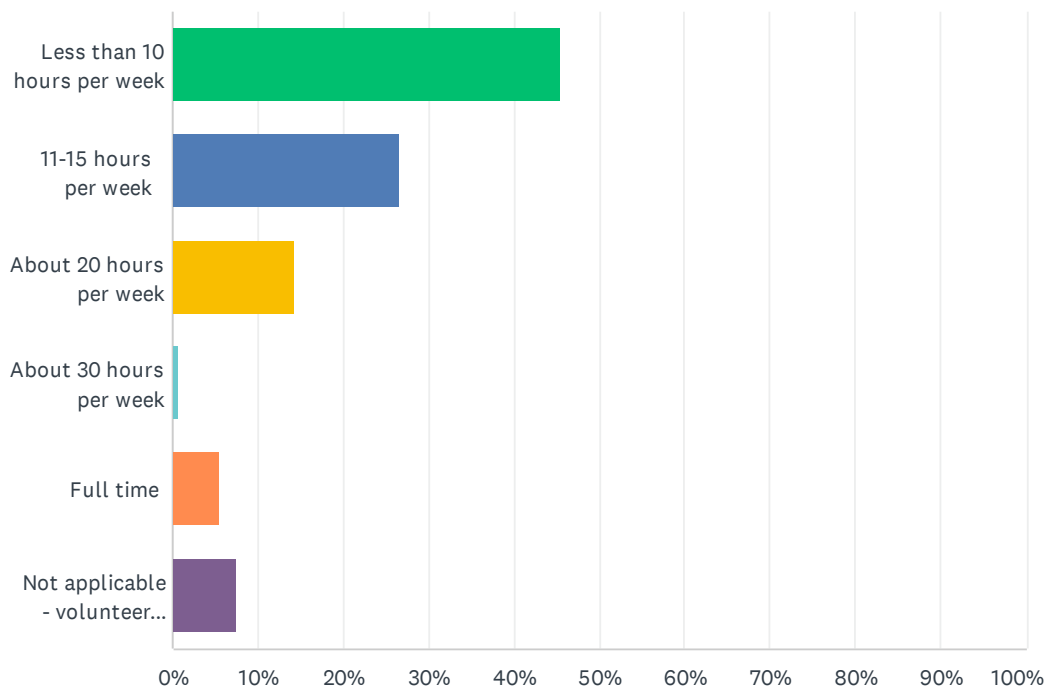

Q11 If funding were available and COVID restrictions were lifted, how many hours per week would be ideal for you to provide PAID work as a CMP?

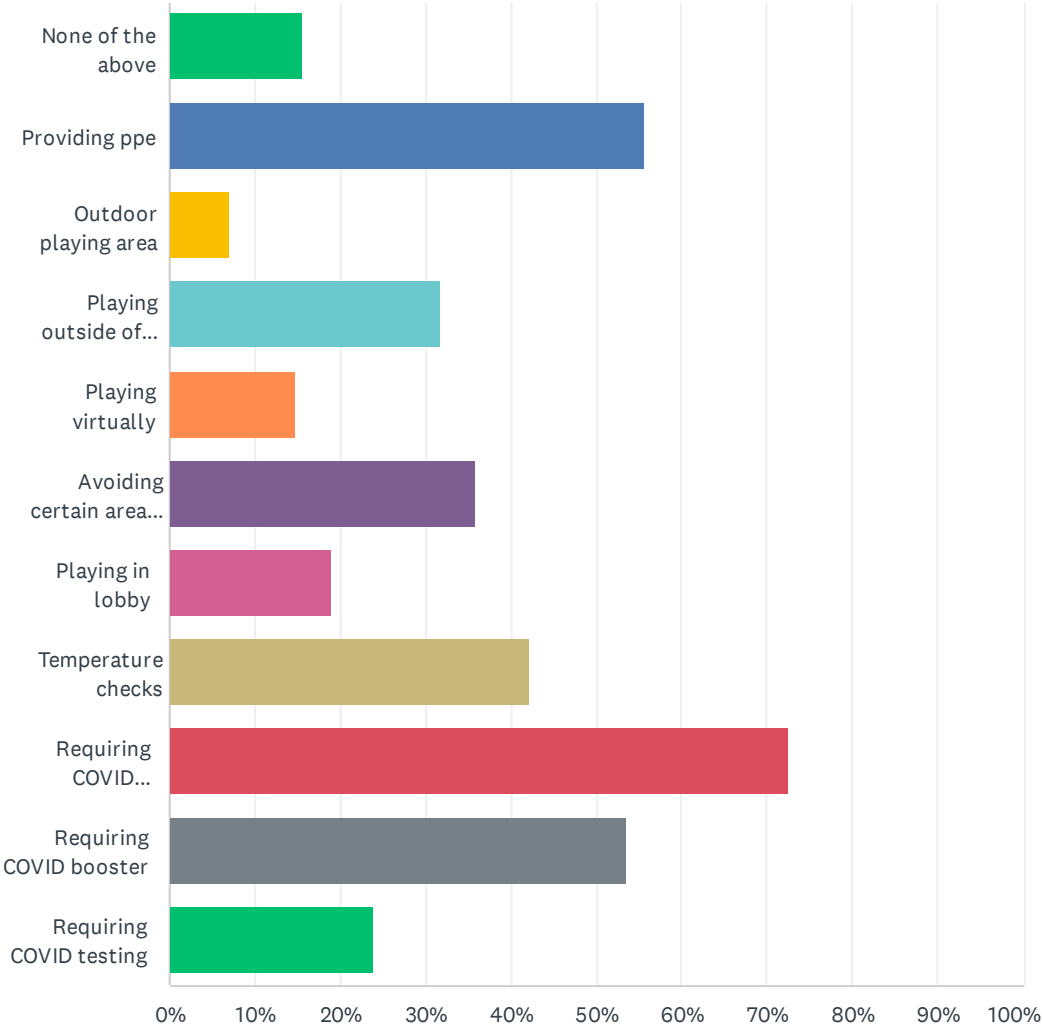

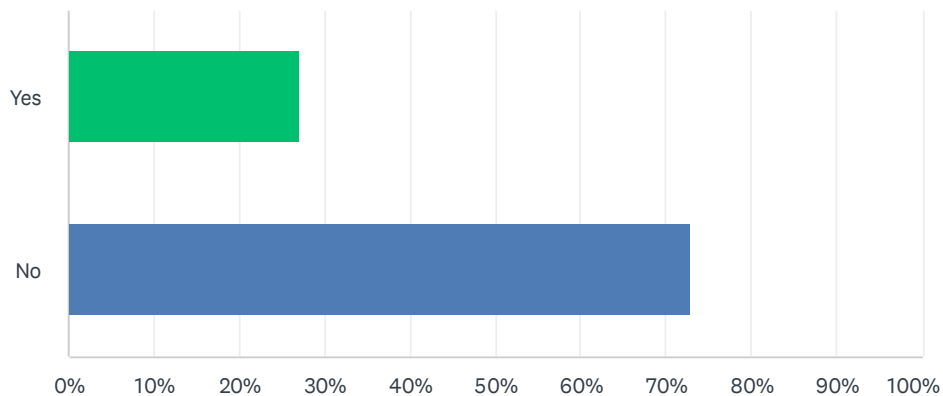

Q13 Were you considered essential personnel by the facility where you work as a CMP?

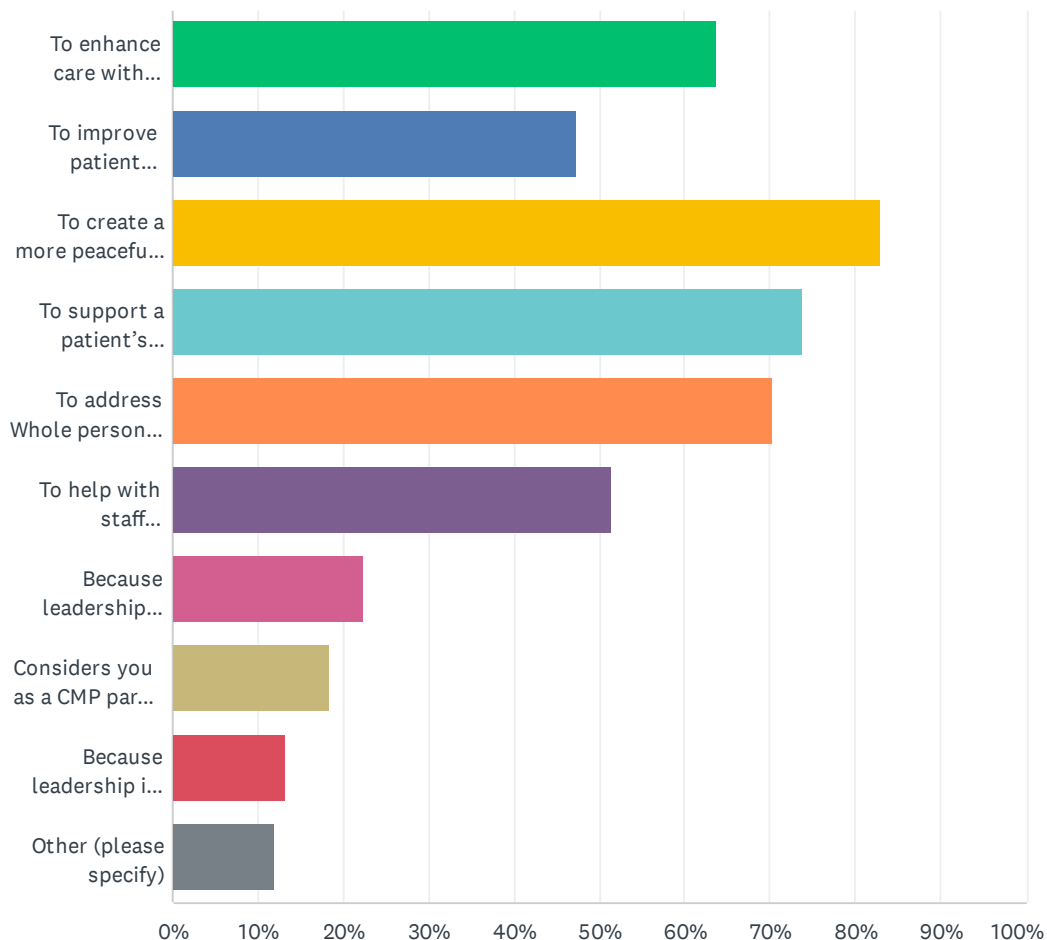

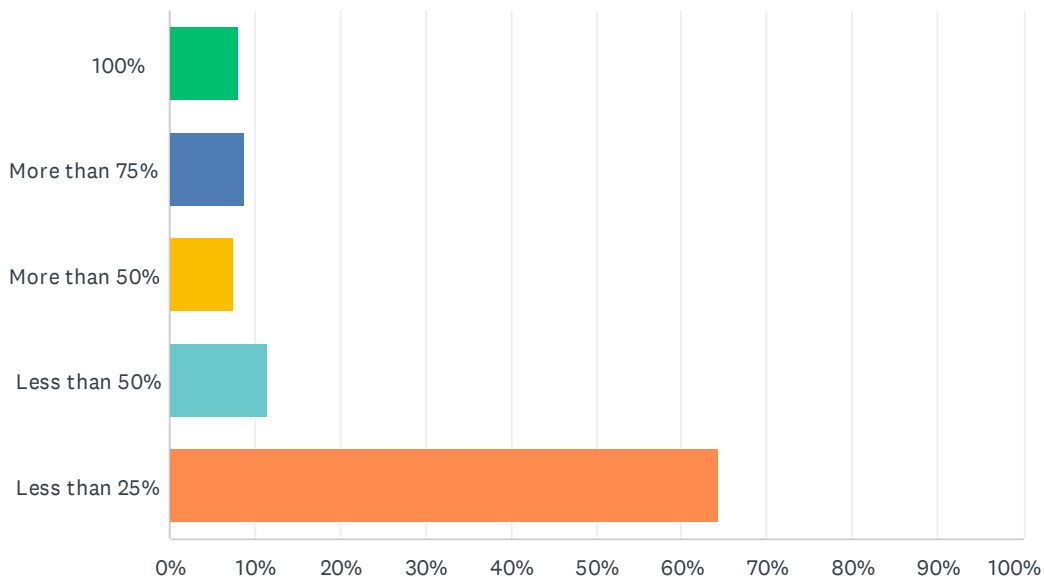

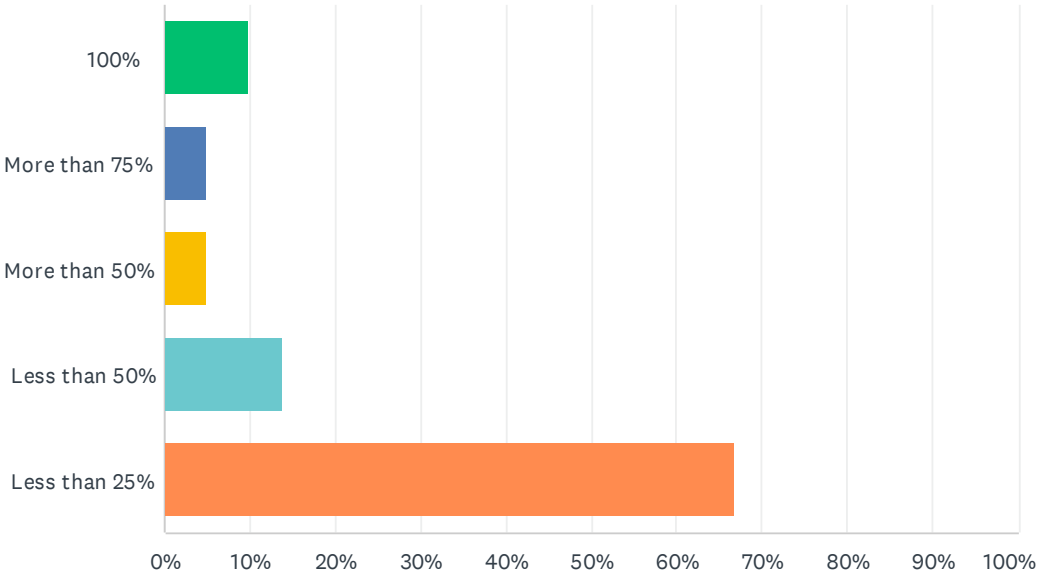

Q16 How much of your income now comes from your work as a CMP?

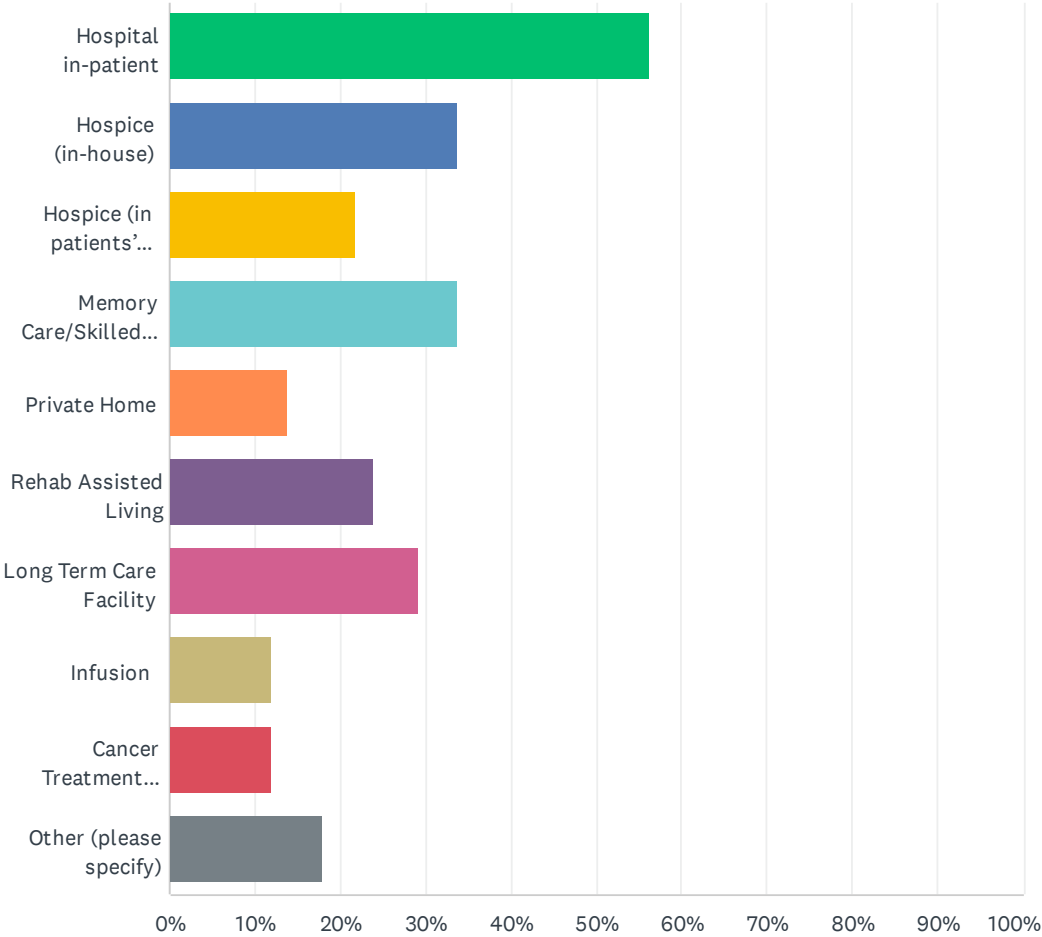

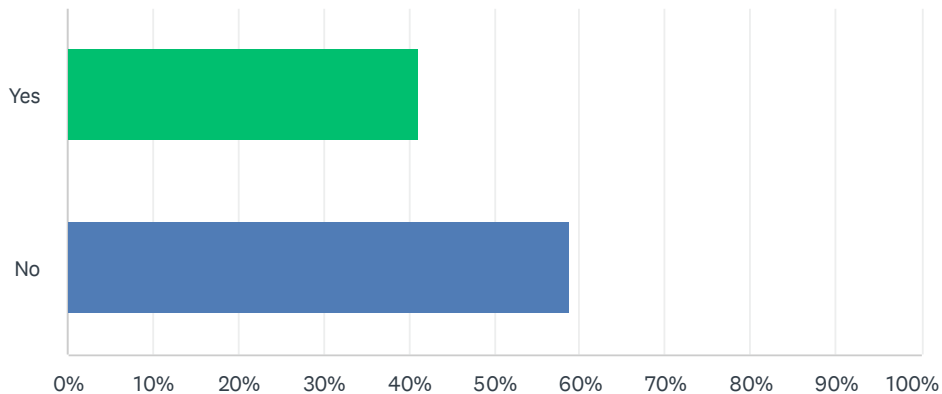

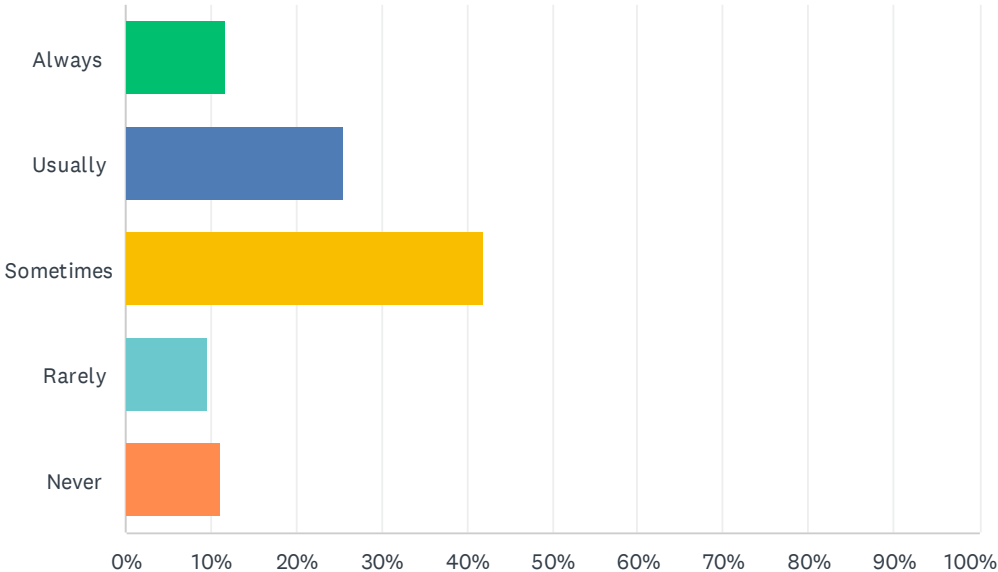

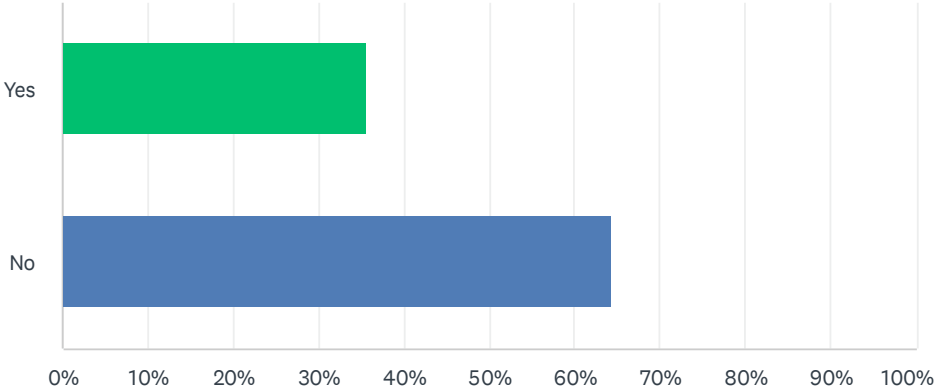

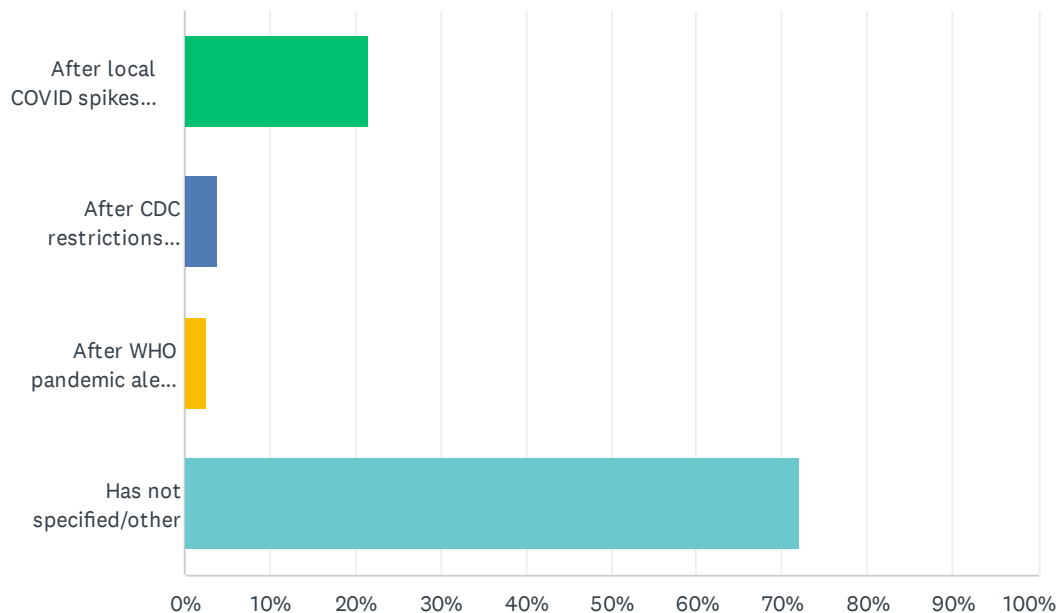

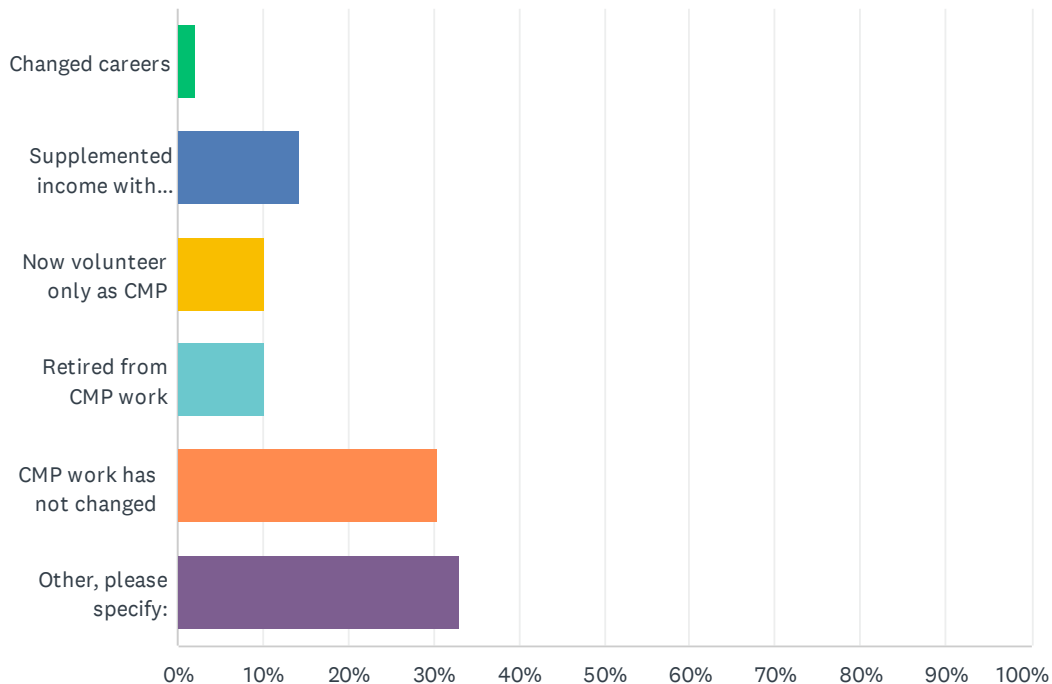
